Dorset is well favoured with many beautiful challenging courses and just as a taster of what Dorset has to offer there are five such golf courses within an easy drive by car. Folke is the closest golf course some 10 minutes away:

Folke is a great design parkland course; nine hole course with alternate tees form a 18 hole, 6000 yard course with water features, trees, doglegs and tricky greens. It is set in the beautiful Dorset countryside away from the hustle and bustle and noise of everyday life. The standard scratch score is 71. Folke Golf Club has stood just outside the quiet little village of Sherborne since it opened in 1991. A fine challenge for high and low handicappers alike, there are plenty of challenges.

Parkland 18 holes (Old Course), 6087 yards Par 71. also 9 holes (Newton), 4867 yards. Par 68.

Visiting golfers, groups and golfing societies are very welcome at Yeovil. Tee times can be arranged between 9:30 and 16:30 Sunday - Friday

Driving range is a fully equipped 16 bay all weather facility. Eleven of the bays have Power Tee technology which enables you to automatically hit balls from the tee, also 2 tier putting green. The 1st hole lies by the River Yeo before a gentle climb to the high downs. The 14th & 15th holes are challenging being below the player with a deep railway cutting on the left of the green. Course designer is Fowler & Allison, founded in 1907.

A parkland golf course with 18 holes, Set over chalky soil and an excellent drainage system, our par-69 course spans 18 holes and 5,467 yards for men, or 4,798 yards for ladies. A 700-yard, six-hole starter course is also available for beginners to develop their skills. Visitors are welcome anytime, although Sundays are mainly competition days.

Beautiful views over Dorset countryside and Weymouth harbour, home of the Weymouth and Portland
